This year

We have had a lovely year exploring the Bible and what it means to know God with your young ones. If you are fairly new to *Adventurers* then here's a quick summary of what we get up to.

Every session we share a Bible story which, along with prayer, is at the heart of our session.

We enjoy a song or two, some games and crafts based on our Bible story. Craft time gives us all a chance to be creative and we use this time to chat about the story. This time together helps to let the children express their thoughts and views on what they've heard.

We encourage everyone to join in or respond to prayer led by one of our adult helpers and encourage the children to experience God through our activities, friendships, sharing and in our beautiful world.
